



## O'Keeffe Museum Presents Arts & Leadership Student Show in Partnership with Santa Fe Community College

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE—July 22, 2024 (Santa Fe, NM)—The Art & Leadership Program at the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum will present its annual student art show on Friday, August 2, at the Santa Fe Community College (SFCC) Visual Arts Gallery with an opening celebration from 5:00 PM—7:00 PM.

"Every year, the students and staff of Art & Leadership look forward to this vibrant, dynamic display of works from future artists," Grace Almanza, Manager of Tour and School Programs at the Museum, said. "It's a display of their growth in art and life skills to their families, friends, and communities."

The show will feature student work created during the camp including sculptures, print making, watercolors, collage, ceramics, fused glass and more.

The Art & Leadership program, now in its 26<sup>th</sup> year, is a free week-long summer

camp for middle school youth. The program was created as an homage to Georgia O'Keeffe's lifelong passion for education and learning. The program is designed to address the gap in artistic development between elementary and high school while focusing on independent thinking, building self-esteem, and strengthening self-respect. Museum staff, program leaders, interns, and teaching artists lead the program, offering children an oasis of positive support and encouragement.

The show will be presented at SFCC this year during preparation for demolition and construction at the show's traditional home, the Museum's Education Annex which will be the site of the New O'Keeffe Museum campus.

"We are thrilled to partner with SFCC for this show and much more," Angie Chandler, Director of Learning and Engagement at the Museum said. "It's a true testament to SFCC's commitment to the community that we were able to find a first-class home for our student's work while our campus awaits exciting changes. We are thankful to the Visual Arts Gallery staff for welcoming us into such a terrific space."
