Assisting the Construction and Maintenance position as well as the Maintenance and Landscape position as needed and coordinating with other Museum staff, volunteers, and scholars. Provides support to the Director of Historic Properties.

Responsibilities include but not limited to

Assists with construction, maintenance, and landscaping as needed to the historic adobe properties including, but not limited to building maintenance and repairs; plastering; landscaping and garden. Curatorial and security assistance.

Performs manual labor; adobe maintenance, plastering, roof maintenance, painting, window and door repair, plumbing, minor electrical, fence construction or repair.

Provides access to and assists with approved visitors, and curatorial issues as requested including care of collections.

Landscaping assistance as needed, including; planting, irrigation, weeding, pruning, mowing, cleaning and repairing paths, and snow removal.

Physical Requirements include, but are not limited to: Regularly standing, walking, climbing, reaching, stooping, bending, crawling, kneeling, talking, hearing, feeling, and lifting up to 75 lbs.
